Histiocytosis in Argentina Since 1991

AIM

 To present the experience of a multidisciplinary study group focused on rare and complex histiocytic disorders.

Langerhans Cell Histiocytosis (LCH)

- Disregulation / abnormal activation of Langerhans cells
- Involvement of skin, lymph nodes, bones, liver, lungs, spleen, Hematologic system, CNS, endocrine glands
- Unifocal or multifocal. Unisystemic or multisystemic. Reversible with no treatment, response to treatment or progressive fatal regardless treatment
- Sequelae: Bone, endocrinologic, CNS, liver, lungs

Hemophagocytic Lymphohistiocytosis (HLH)

- Disregulation and abnormal activation of Macrophages. Fever. Involvement of hematologic system, liver, spleen, CNS, biochemical abnormalities
- Bone Marrow Transplantation mandatory for HLH patients with genetic or progressive disease after initial treatment
- CNS sequelae

LCH: Incidence in Argentina Hospital Garrahan

- Mean annual rate for children < 15 years old:
 5.1 / 1,000,000
